Dear Parent/Carer

As your son/daughter draws towards the end of their academic career at The Hamble School we would like to take this opportunity to thank you for all of the support that you have given. It has been vital in ensuring that he/she is as prepared as possible for the examinations which are now underway.

In addition, I would like to make you aware of the final arrangements at this crucial time so that the final weeks run smoothly:

Attendance up to Friday 15 June:

The final day for Year 11 students will be Friday 15 June. Students will be expected to attend school as normal in full uniform up to and including the 15 June and will follow their normal timetable.

In the circumstance where all examinations for a subject have been finished students are expected to attend their scheduled lesson as normal. They will then be supported in completing revision for their remaining examination subjects. Please ensure that your son/daughter is well prepared for completing their revision sessions.

Students are permitted to go home after their morning science exam on Friday 15 June if they do not have a graphics top up and they do not have an exam in the afternoon. All students will need to have their sign off sheet completed before they leave school on Friday 15 June.

Attendance 18 - 25 June:

From the 18 June it is compulsory for students to attend:

- All timetabled lessons which have examinations left to complete
- All timetabled 'Warm up' and 'Top up' sessions

Students will receive their GCSE results on Thursday 23 August.


