Dear Parent/Carer

Year 11- Prom Points 2018.

The Hamble School's Prom is a privilege and honour to be part of as well as a spectacular celebration for our students and their 5 years of hard work and dedication; it is a lovely way to celebrate the completion of the students' secondary education career and the next steps they will be taking.

As your child enters their final year of academic study at The Hamble School we are writing to you with some important information regarding the qualifying criteria for an invitation to the Prom in 2018.

As you are no doubt aware, the remaining months are vital for your child's education and therefore we expect a certain standard of on-going behaviour, attendance and focus during this time. In order for there to be clarity regarding the criteria that needs to be achieved to attend the Prom, and more importantly that you do not incur any unnecessary expense, the following criteria will apply.

Students will need to earn a minimum of 500 points between September 2017 and April 2018. Points will be awarded for attendance, punctuality, progress, effort and attainment in lessons and attendance at intervention, as well as other after school events; the details of which have been shared with the students in an assembly. If your child has any concerns regarding this matter then please ask them to speak with myself or Mrs Barkshire in the Heads of Year office. Once your child has met the required prom points they will be notified and further information regarding the Prom and Prom invitations will be supplied.

I would urge you to support and encourage your child with the above expectations. It is important that their remaining time at The Hamble School is focussed on achieving the best outcomes possible. The Prom is always a fantastic occasion and I am very much looking forward to welcoming the entire year group to their Prom in 2018.
