## Year 10 – Raising Achievement Evening

The Hamble School would like to invite you to our first Raising Achievement Evening for Year 10 which will take place on **Thursday 14 September 2017** from **5.30pm to 6.30pm**.

We are sure you will agree that Year 10 is a crucially important year for your child. With this in mind, we want to help both parents / carers and our students to recognise how challenging the year ahead will be.
