Raising Achievement Evening – Part 2

Following on from our overwhelmingly successful Raising Achievement Evening in September, The Hamble School would like to invite you to our next Raising Achievement Evening for Years 10 and 11 which will take place on **Thursday 01 November 2018** from **6.00pm to 7.00pm**.

This important evening will form the second in our programme of three evenings throughout this academic year for Years 10 and 11. The purpose of this second essential evening is to:

- outline the purpose and expectations of the upcoming mock examinations season for Year 11 in November and Landmark Assessments for Year 10,
- receive an introduction to college applications, college deadlines and careers advice, and
- developing effective learning to learn skills and associated revision strategies to best prepare for the upcoming mock examinations with our visiting speaker Shirley Eastwood.
