Year 10 PSHCRE Day – Friday 14 December 2018

All Year 10 students will be taking part in a PSHCRE Day, entitled 'Planning for Your Future'. This forms part of the Personal Social Health Careers and Religious Education (PSHCRE) statutory requirements.

Every Year 10 Student will be off timetable for the day and will have the opportunity to participate in sessions run by guest speakers who are experts in their fields. Sessions will be conducted by a variety of people/organisations and are organised as one-hour interactive workshops. The following sessions have been arranged:

- **University of Southampton**
- **University of Bournemouth**
- **Southampton City College**
- **ExxonMobil**
- **Andy Dudley – HM Revenue and Customs**
- **Jo Adey – The Royal Navy**

In the afternoon all students will be carrying out a reflection session to plan for their future and will explore their vision for the next 10 years.

Your son/daughter will be required to wear full school uniform for the day unless they are taking part in the Christmas Jumper Day, in which case they will be required to follow the guidelines for this. All daily arrangements, such as the beginning and end of the school day will remain unchanged. Your child will be required to bring basic equipment with them e.g. pen, pencil, ruler and planner. They do not need to bring any exercise books.

Students will be given a booklet, which they will be encouraged to use for reflection and take home to discuss with parents/carers. A member of The Hamble School teaching staff will also be with them for each session, if they have any questions or concerns.
