Dear Parents/Carers

Year 9 PSHCRE Day – Friday 17th November 2017

On Friday 17 November all year 9 students will be taking part in a PSHCRE Day, entitled 'Preparing for the Future'. This forms part of the Personal Social Health Careers and Religious Education (PSHCRE) statutory requirements.

Every year 9 Student will be off timetable for the day and will have the opportunity to participate in sessions run by guest speakers on various issues. Sessions will be conducted by:

- **Shannon Redding** – 'Love is patient, love is kind' – Consent, respectful relationships, contraception.
- **Southampton University** – 'Design your own Uni student' – Post-16 choices, university applications and courses.
- **Bournemouth University** – Student ambassadors and admissions – Post-16 choices, university applications, courses and being a university student.
- **The Army** – Post-16 choices, careers and life in the army.
- **Rotary** – Charities, running businesses and wellbeing.
- **Explore** – Different types of relationships, healthy relationships.
- **Chris Lubbe** – Inspirational speaker and life coach. Education, resilience and life in apartheid South Africa.

Your child will be required to wear full school uniform and all daily arrangements, such as the beginning and end of the school day, will remain unchanged. Your child will be required to bring basic equipment with them such as pen, pencil, ruler and planner. They do not need to bring any other equipment, such as books.

Your son/daughter will be given a booklet, which they will be encouraged to use for reflection and take home to discuss with parents/carers. A member of The Hamble School teaching staff will also be with them for each session, to address any questions or concerns they may have.
