Year 11 PSHCRE Day – Friday 08 December 2017

On Friday 08 November all year 11 students will be taking part in a PSHCRE Day, entitled 'Preparing for the Future'. This forms part of the Personal Social Health Careers and Religious Education (PSHCRE) statutory requirements.

Every Year 11 Student will be off timetable for the day and will have the opportunity to participate in sessions run by guest speakers on various issues. Sessions will be conducted by a variety of organisations, such as:

- Southampton University
- Bournemouth University
- Sparsholt College
- City College
- The Army
- Voluntary groups such as The Rotary Club and Christian Aid

Your child will be required to wear full school uniform and all daily arrangements, such as the beginning and end of the school day, will remain unchanged. Your child will be required to bring basic equipment with them such as pen, pencil, ruler and planner. They do not need to bring any other equipment, such as books.

Your son/daughter will be given a booklet, which they will be encouraged to use for reflection and to take home to discuss with parents/carers. A member of The Hamble School teaching staff will also be with them for each session, to address any questions or concerns they may have.
