Wednesday 30th January 2019	<i>An Inspector Calls</i> How the characters' language reveals more about them e.g. mood or social class.
Wednesday 5th February 2019	<i>Romeo and Juliet.</i> Exam style question. How does Shakespeare explore the feelings and the relationship between Romeo and Friar Lawrence?
