ATTENDANCE


All students are expected to return in September. If your child has a medical condition that will make this difficult, please contact the school's Attendance Officer as soon as possible and we will work with you.

EQUIPMENT

Students should have their own equipment and we will send you details of what is recommended. Packs of equipment/ single items can be purchased from the school.

THE SCHOOL DAY

Children will follow their normal school timetable. We will operate year group 'bubbles' and a one-way system to avoid students mixing with other year groups.

LESSONS

Classrooms will be arranged in rows, and doors and windows will remain open where possible. Students will be asked to use hand sanitizer when entering and exiting lessons. We are asking students to bring in their own hand sanitizer for use at other times.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

All students are expected to wear full school uniform and the guidance is that this does not need to be washed more regularly than usual. If students have PE, they should wear their PE kit into school as we are avoiding using the changing rooms.

CLEANING

Personal hygiene is more crucial than ever and children should wash their hands after break, lunch and any trips to the toilet. All teaching rooms will be cleaned between sessions. Our cleaners will focus on touch points during the day.

TRAVELLING TO SCHOOL

Students should avoid travelling with students in different year groups where possible. If students are using public transport, they will be expected to wear a face covering. There will be bins at the school entrances for disposable face masks.

BREAK AND LUNCHTIMES

To reduce mixing, each year group will be allocated a zone for break and lunch. They should remain in these zones, except to purchase food or go to the toilet. Where possible, we are asking students to bring in packed lunch. We will be offering a reduced catering service with an outlet for each year group.

ENTERING THE SCHOOL

Please use the normal school entrances. Face coverings should not be worn during the school day, except where there are specific medical conditions. They should be packed away, preferably in a separate bag.

We will still run interventions for Year 11 students. There will be some extra-curricular and sporting activities but these will probably be limited.
