Marwell Alternative Timetable – Year 7

On **Monday 04 March 2019** your child will be participating in lessons in school linked into the topic of ecosystems, as they remain on site rather than attending the Marwell Geography Fieldwork visit. Your child will follow a revised timetable for this day **only** and the timetable will be communicated to your child through their tutor.

The following lessons have been arranged for all students to complete:

- **English** – Creative writing on the Amazon rainforest.
- **Maths** – Putting animal attributes into Venn diagrams and studying ratios through looking at porcupines.
- **Science** – Ecological surveys of the school site.
- **Geography** – Locating world biomes and adaptations in plants and animals.

In addition to the lessons above, students will also complete **one** of lessons indicated below. This will be highlighted in the timetable your child will receive from their tutor.

- **Art** – Butterfly printing, which links into their current topic on colour theory.
- **Music** – Making soundscapes in Mixcraft (a computer programme that makes music), using the stimulus of ‘a journey through the jungle’.

Your child will be required to wear full school uniform and bring all equipment expected of a normal school day. All timing for the day, such as beginning and end of the school day and break times, will remain unchanged. Your child will not need to bring any of their class books on this day.
