Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 7: Wednesday 5 September 2018

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all once again for your support with the transition process. We are very much looking forward to the Year 6 students beginning their exciting journey with us on 5 September 2018.

I would like to outline the plan for the students on their first day at The Hamble School.

The school day will begin at the normal time of 08.30am. Students are advised to enter the school via the student entrance and then head to the main hall where they will be met by their tutors.

Following the Year 7 Assembly students will spend time with their tutor and will then attend lessons. We would like the students to bring in their scrapbooks and induction booklets that were received on induction day.

During the morning session students will be taken to the hall, registered for cashless catering and will be shown how to put money on their account. It would be useful to send your child in with a small amount of cash on the first day; we would recommend that students would only need £2.15 to buy a meal for the school day. If you have opted for your child not to have their finger scanned, they will be given a card to use which will allow them to load money onto their account.

For those students who choose to bring a packed lunch we would encourage you to support our healthy school accreditation. We do not allow students to consume fizzy or sugary drinks; this includes all energy drinks.

Any student who is eligible for free school meals will have lunch provided on the day.

I would also like to take this chance to remind students that if they have purchased a Scholars Educational Season Ticket for the train this must be collected from Mrs E Loveday at the window in the Main School office on Wednesday 5 September 2018 during break and lunch time.
