Year 9 PSHCRE Day – Thursday 27 June 2019

All Year 9 students will be taking part in a PSHCRE Day, entitled 'Conflict, Faith and Peace', on **Thursday 27 June 2019**. This forms part of the Personal, Social, Health, Careers and Religious Education (PSHCRE) statutory requirements.

Year 9 students will be off timetable for the day and will have the opportunity to participate in sessions run by guest speakers on various issues. The following sessions have been arranged:

- **UN Women** – Conflict, Faith and Peace within the United Nations
- **Humanism** – Exploring Humanist core beliefs and attitudes
- **Bursledon Parish Church** – What is faith and what do Christians believe?
- **The Salvation Army** – Social action
- **Pax Christi UK** – Peace and human security
- **Southampton Council of Faiths** – Buddhism and interfaith
- **TADIC (Young people's wellbeing service)** – Keep Safe project

Your child will be required to wear full school uniform, and all daily arrangements, such as the beginning and end of the school day will remain unchanged. Your son/daughter will need to bring basic equipment with them e.g. pen, pencil, ruler and planner, however, they do not need to bring any subject books.

Every student will be given a booklet, which they will be encouraged to use for reflection and take home to discuss with parents/carers. A member of The Hamble School teaching staff will also be with them for each session, if they have any questions or concerns during the day.
