Progress Check Week

I do hope you and your family are all keeping well and managing to get back into a routine this week. I am writing to you regarding the new **Progress Check Week** which is the week beginning **Monday 27 April** for **Year 7**.

The aim of the Progress Check Week is to ensure students receive feedback on aspects of Home Learning and assess student strengths/weaknesses for accurate future planning. Each year group will have one Progress Check Week per half term until we return to normal schooling. It must be stressed that these are not assessment weeks and the assignments published should not be completed as examinations. I have outlined the expectations below:

- During the week beginning Monday 27 April students will be set one assignment per subject studied on Show My Homework. They will not be set any other work for that subject during the week.
- Each assignment should take 45 minutes and will usually consist of multiple-choice questions and longer responses.
- All instructions will be put on Show My Homework, along with support materials and links to any other relevant information.
- Students are able to ask staff questions via the comment box on Show My Homework.
- Work should be submitted on one of the following platforms: Show My Homework, Office Forms, Google Forms or Edmodo. Full instructions on submission for each subject will be included in the information on Show My Homework.
