Uniform Expectations

We do have very high expectations and we ask for your support in ensuring that your child adheres to the school's uniform policy. An overview of the school's uniform policy has been provided below for your reference:

- Black loose fitting trousers or a Thornton style skirt
- Plain white collared shirt with the top button done up.
- The Hamble School tie in house colour with 8 visible stripes.
- The Hamble School jumper in house colour (Optional Year 11)
- Navy Blue Blazer with the Hamble logo
- Black formal leather style plain black shoes.

If for any reason your child cannot adhere to the uniform policy, then they may be kept out of circulation with their tutor until we can rectify the issue. We will try where possible to find a solution for students within school. Failing this, we may ask for your support to bring in the correct or missing uniform items.
