- Through a challenging, broad and balanced curriculum the needs of each individual are met, enabling them to achieve the highest academic success.
- We offer a wide range of subjects at Key Stage 4 including: Triple Science, a range of Languages, Humanities, Computer Science as well as Engineering, Technology, Business Studies, Media, Performing Arts, and Statistics.
- Our students have consistently achieved high outcomes in GCSEs and BTECs over the last four years.
- Specialist facilities for those with sporting talent include an Olympic gymnastics hall, astro turf, hockey/football pitches, superb floodlit tennis courts, fitness suite and dance studio.
- We offer an Express Stream Programme which provides enhanced opportunities for students with high prior attainment.
- Parents and carers are actively encouraged to be involved in their child's learning as they progress through the school.
- Our staff are highly qualified specialists who care passionately about their subject and every student.



We recognise that each student is a unique individual and we provide an extensive range of opportunities for students to broaden their experience and develop their interests, skills and talents.

SPORT: Students can take advantage of the fantastic facilities and participate in a wide range of sports including: athletics, badminton, basketball, cricket, dance, football, hockey, gymnastics, rugby, netball, tennis, trampolining and swimming.

CREATIVE AND PERFORMING ARTS:

There is the opportunity to learn a new skill or showcase musical talent by taking up a musical instrument or performing in our extensive music groups. Students can develop their creative abilities by attending art club and exhibiting their work. Our annual drama production and drama club provide the opportunity for students to develop their acting and performance skills as well as cultural experiences visiting local theatres.

STEM: Our Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics departments provide a range of clubs for students to get involved in. Our Science club is very popular with Year 7 students and we have good links with the University of Southampton. Our Engineering students regularly compete at regional innovation competitions and we have established links with local businesses.

TRIPS AND TRAVEL ABROAD: Life at The Hamble School is further enhanced by opportunities to visit local, national and international locations. We have a number of trips built into our curriculum provision including travel abroad opportunities, for example, ski trips, language exchange visits, New York and a regular Battlefields trip.

DUKE OF EDINBURGH AWARD: In Year 10 students have the opportunity to engage in the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award through the school. The programme enables students to help in the community, develop new skills, and plan and complete an expedition.





All students at The Hamble School are well looked after in a happy and supportive environment. Our strong pastoral care system provides excellent personal guidance and fosters a sense of community. We have a culture of high expectations, tolerance and respect.

- Our Year 6 into 7 transition programme, in which we meet every child and family individually, ensures a smooth and happy transfer from primary to secondary school.
- Our Personal, Social, Health and Careers programme is designed to help our students reflect on their own experiences and cultivate their individual attributes, building selfesteem and resilience to ensure that they are prepared for life beyond school.
- Every child has a tutor to guide and support them, giving parents a personal point of contact. Progress Leaders know their students well and ensure they receive the support they need.
- Our house system offers the opportunity for healthy competition and fosters a sense of pride in the school community as well as an exciting reward system.
- Students have the opportunity to take responsibility and develop their leadership skills by representing the school as a mentor, becoming a school senior or junior prefect or as part of the Student Leadership Team.
