


BLENDING LEARNING – FAQ


1. Where can I find my child's work for the week?

All work for the week will now be available on a Monday to allow students to work flexibly around the live lessons. If students are using a desktop version of Show My Homework, they need to go to the 'calendar' tab on the left-hand side and ensure they are viewing the correct week. It will look like the image below. The Weekly Learning Plans which contain all the details of the tasks can be downloaded from the resource section on each subject post.



Open the subject assignment by double clicking on the green bars. Go to the bottom of the relevant assignment page and download the Weekly Learning Log, which is available as a Word or PDF document.

If your child uses the Show My Homework App on their phone, they need to select 'all' on their to do list and look forward to Friday (as this is the due date). Students can then open each subject and download the Weekly Learning Plan from the attachments.



Students should be reminded that this is their work for the **week** and they have five days to work through it. On each Show My Homework post there will also be additional resources to support students. If they need help, they can still message teachers on Show My Homework in the usual way.



2. How do I find out details of my child's Zoom lessons?

3. Why has a teacher not allowed my child into a Zoom lesson?

Students must enter the Zoom waiting room with their full name as printed on our school register. For safeguarding reasons, we cannot let students in unless they are using their full name. To ensure you set Zoom to the correct name, please follow the instructions in the letter sent home last week. You must do this before you enter the waiting room. 4. How does my child organise their time between live lessons?

As we are now including some live lessons to increase student contact with teachers. This does mean that independent tasks need to be set on a weekly basis rather than daily, so that our staff are available to teach online. We would suggest that your child uses the live lesson timetable to help them plan their day. They can slot their independent tasks in between the live lessons – the timetable templates on the letter to parents/ carers will help with this. For example:
