#### **BACK TO SCHOOL**

Government guidance requires secondary schools to test all students on-site before they return to school following the summer holidays. These lateral flow tests must be 3-5 days apart. The timetable for tests/return to school is as follows.

A few points about the above table:

- Thursday 2 September is an INSED day so there will be no work set that day.
- On Friday 3 September, we will set work for all year groups. This
  will be available on Class Charts. The new Year 7 students will
  complete transition work this will be on Edmodo.
- On Monday 6 September students (excluding Year 7) will have 3 live lessons (using Zoom) and 2 hours of set work.
- On Tuesday 7 September, we will only be delivering set work.
   This is because of the large number of staff involved in the Year 7 transition day and lateral flow testing.
- Year 7s will start school on Tuesday 7 September; Years 10 and 11 will start on Wednesday 8 September; and all year groups will be back in by Thursday 9 September.



# LATERAL FLOW TESTING



Appointment times for Lateral Flow Testing in school were sent to parents/ carers before the summer holidays. Unfortunately, we are unable to change these times, unless there are exceptional circumstances. If you have any questions about the arrangements, please email general@thehambleschool.co.uk

#### **STUDENT REMOTE LEARNING**

On Monday 6 September students will have 3 live lessons (using Zoom) and 2 set work lessons. For all other days (excluding Thursday 2 September, which is an INSED Day) students will be set independent tasks to complete for all lessons that they would usually have on that day.

Students will access their work on Class Charts in the same way in which they access homework and previous remote learning. In order for Class Charts to be user friendly for students, teachers make the issue date and the due date as the same day as the lesson and they will also use the following format in the title box **DATE: LESSON NUMBER: LIVE LESSON OR SET WORK: SUBJECT**. This does mean that tasks will not appear on Class Charts until the day of the lesson. The majority of our students have said this is easier. When students log in on the Monday, they will be able to clearly identify which lessons are live and which are set work. When a lesson is complete, students should click on complete in order to keep their Class Charts page organised.

## **UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS**

In preparation for September we would ask all parents/ carers to check the uniform and equipment list carefully. The main items are:

- Black loose-fitting trousers or a Thornton style skirt
- Plain white collared shirt with the top button done up
- The Hamble School tie in house colour with 8 visible stripes
- The Hamble School jumper in house colour
- Navy Blue Blazer with the Hamble logo
- Black formal leather-style polishable plain black shoes.

Our policy states that shoes must be formal leather-style plain black shoes with black soles and no decorative stitching. Shoes must be polishable – please note that patent is not acceptable as it is not polishable.

Please see below the types of shoes that are not acceptable from this term. We also do not allow boots, trainers, steel toe capped shoes, logos, stripes, canvas or sports-style shoes.





### **EQUIPMENT EXPECTATIONS**


Students must bring their own equipment to school every day; the following stationary is expected and tutors will carry out regular equipment checks to ensure students are remembering to bring this to school:
