
# YEAR 8 PSHCRE 'IN PERSON' THEME DAYS

Our Year 8 students were lucky enough to be the first year group to return to 'in person' theme days for PSHCRE on 4th November 2021. They took part in some informative and useful sessions led by Accredited Relationships and Sexual Health Practitioner, Shannon Reddin. We were very lucky to have Shannon in school and learn from her – she is also the Founder of Enrich-RSE and Co Founder of Ready2Shine CIC.

Students had the opportunity to learn about puberty and the changes they should expect as they grow up, and Shannon made sure she answered as many student questions as she was able to – there were lots of them! Shannon was full of praise for Hamble students: 'It was such an enjoyable day and I thought the students were all a pleasure to work with.' Students also took part in a lesson focused on harmful language which explored how our language choices can affect others.




