Academic Transition

Between Tuesday 27 June and Thursday 20 July teachers from the Hamble School will be visiting Bursledon Junior School, Netley Abbey Junior School and Hamble Primary School to deliver transition lessons to Year 6 students. These sessions will take place on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons.

I am writing to ask whether your child would like to support with these lessons in his/ her role as a Transition Prefect. This will involve assisting the teacher in the classroom and helping the Year 6s with their work. We will travel to the schools via mini bus and a limited number of students will be able to attend each session. I will, however, ensure that everyone who would like to participate gets a chance to do so.

Students will need to attend in full school uniform (except blazers, which are currently optional) and ensure that they act as role models for the younger students. As we will leave school before lunchtime time, students will need to bring a packed lunch/ water bottle or purchase their food in the canteen at breaktime.

Please note that if your child opts to help at Netley Abbey Junior School and Hamble Primary they will return to The Hamble School after the end of our school day and will therefore need to make arrangements to get home at a later time.
