Battlefields Trip: Thursday 23 October 2025 – Saturday 25 October 2025

I am delighted to be writing to you to invite you to a Parent/ Carer Information evening on Thursday **11 September 2025, 5.00pm - 6.00pm** in the Main Hall. This information evening will outline the final itinerary for each day of the trip and will provide a complete list of items students will require for the duration of the trip.

We are departing The Hamble School at approximately 6.00am on Thursday 23 October 2025 travelling with Horseman Coaches to Dover. From here we will sail with P&O ferries to Calais before travelling by coach to our accommodation. We will return to The Hamble School at approximately 6.30pm on Saturday 25 October 2025.

As a reminder, the total cost of the trip is £528. This will need to be paid in full on Scopay by no later than Tuesday 16 September 2025. The payment schedule is below for your reference. If for any reason your child can no longer attend the trip please note that refunds can only be given when a replacement student has been found and their deposit paid to the school.

Payment 1: £150 payment Due 6 June 2025

Payment 2: £151 payment Due 4 July 2025

Payment 3: £152 payment Due 5 September 2025

If your child is travelling on a non-UK passport please can you contact us as soon as possible to discuss some additional paperwork that may need completing. Without this paperwork your child may be unable to travel to France.

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
