Brighton Coastal Town – Year 10

As part of the Year 11 photography topic 'Creative Landscape' the Creative Arts department is organising a trip to Brighton coastal town on **Thursday 29 June.** This trip will be a valuable experience for the students as it will provide an opportunity to explore a local landmark and record their experience using photographic techniques, which will be planned in school prior to the visit. The photographs taken by the students during the trip will help develop evidence for the GCSE assessment objectives going into year 11.

Throughout the day, we will follow a planned route of Brighton as one group. Students will each be given a workbook to complete during the day as a guide for their photography. All students are expected to meet our highest expectations of behaviour.

Your child is expected to arrive at The Hamble School by **8:00am** ready to depart from school at **8:30am**. The mode of transport will be school minibus. Students will depart Brighton at **2:30pm** and we anticipate to return to school by **4:00pm**. We ask that parents are flexible with this return time owing to any unexpected road traffic.

Students can bring their own packed lunch to the trip or bring money to buy food and must wear their school uniform but are permitted to wear comfortable footwear for walking. If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal, a packed lunch will be provided.

If you give permission for your child to attend the day then please make a payment of £5.00 by **Friday 16 June on Scopay.** Payments can also be made by cash/ cheque – Please include the exact amount in an envelope and hand into the Main office, if you wish to use this method of payment. All parents/ carers will also need to complete the consent form on EVOLVE.
