## NCFE Health and Fitness - Final NEA Coursework Assessment

We are writing to inform you that during the week beginning **Monday 13 October 2025**, students will begin their Non-Examined Assessment (NEA) coursework, which accounts for 60% of their final grade in the NCFE Health and Fitness qualification.

This is a critical and final assessment, which must be completed by **Thursday 9 January 2026**. The NEA will take place during timetabled Health and Fitness NCFE lessons, under formal exam conditions, and will total 24 hours of assessed work. Full attendance during this period is therefore essential.

Students have been reminded of the importance of maintaining strict exam conditions throughout. Any student who fails to follow these guidelines will be asked to leave the room, which could significantly affect their ability to complete this final component.

Please note that once the NEA begins, staff are not permitted to offer assistance during lesson time. However, we are committed to providing comprehensive support beforehand to ensure that all students feel fully prepared.

To support this, we will be holding a targeted intervention session on Monday 6 October 2025, from 3.00 pm to 4.30 pm. While attendance is not compulsory, we strongly encourage students to take part, as the session will provide valuable preparation for the upcoming NEA.

In addition, Miss Bennett will be running weekly intervention sessions every Monday morning from 7.30 am to 8.30 am in SC15, giving students the opportunity to receive extra guidance before they begin their coursework.

We cannot stress enough how important this assessment is, and your support in encouraging attendance and preparation will be greatly appreciated.
