Choir Performance at The Anvil, Basingstoke

On Tuesday 07 March 2023, the School Choir will be taking part in a prestigious performance at The Anvil in Basingstoke. This event *My Voice; Our Song* is run by Hampshire Music Service.

Your son/ daughter is part of the school choir run by Jessica Orba (our singing teacher) and they have been working hard towards this event. The aim of the event is to consider the link between singing and wellbeing. Singing in a group is powerful, and with this large-scale concert, your son/daughter will get to sing in a 1,000 strong choir.
