Year 10 Art

Students have now started the 'Natural Forms' coursework unit in their GCSE art lessons. While students were settling into the course in the autumn term, we provided them with a soft cover sketchbook. However, from this point onwards, students need to purchase a sketchbook for each project in the course. Details of this are as follows:

Year 10 Spring Term <i>Natural Forms</i>	A4 Spiralbound sketchbook	£3.50
Year 10 Summer Term <i>Coursework unit 3</i>	A3 Spiralbound sketchbook	£4.00
Year 11 Spring Term <i>Externally set assignment</i>	A4 or A3 Spiralbound sketchbook	£3.50/£4.00

For the 'Natural Forms' project, students need an A4 hardback spiralbound sketchbook. The paper in the book must be high quality cartridge paper.

Sketchbooks of this type can be purchased via Scopay at a cost of £3.50. Students then need to show proof of purchase to a member of staff from the art department. We will then be able to give them their book.

You are welcome to purchase a sketchbook elsewhere, however, we would ask that you make sure it does have a hardcover, is spiralbound and contains high quality cartridge paper. Sketchbooks of a similar quality to the ones provided by the school retail from £8.00.

Other art materials will be available to purchase through the school in due course. If there is anything you would like us to consider making available for students to purchase, to support them in completing work at home, then please do let us know and we can look into cost effective ways of making these available.
