REMINDERS FOR THE

NEW ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

A reminder that the government guidance requires secondary schools to test all students on-site before they return to school following the summer holidays. Students are also encouraged to continue with the twice weekly testing at home for the rest of this term and the autumn term. The school has to offer 2 lateral flow tests before students return to school. These tests must be 3-5 days apart. Due to these requirements we will have a staggered return to school in September.
