
The staggered start to the school year will ensure that each year group has a chance to get used to the new routines and systems. Mr Govan has outlined the schedule for the first week but as a reminder our first week is detailed below:

- Monday 7th September Year 7 in school
- Tuesday 8th September Year 7 and 8 in school
- Wednesday 9th September Year 7 and 9 in school
- Thursday 10th September Year 7 and 11 in school
- Friday 11th September Year 7, 10 and 11 in school
- Monday 14th September All year groups in school

When students are not physically in school they will be expected to log onto Show My Homework and 'attend' online lessons using Zoom. ### **CLASSROOMS**

When students return next week the classrooms will look a bit different. Where possible desks will be arranged in rows and doors and windows will be open to allow for ventilation. Students will be asked to use hand sanitizer when entering and leaving lessons. All teaching rooms will also be cleaned between sessions.



## **EQUIPMENT PACKS FOR STUDENTS**

Students must not share equipment in lessons and it will be difficult for teachers to lend this to students due to Health and Safety/cleaning measures. The only exception to this is specialist equipment e.g. Art materials, which will be cleaned between use. We would therefore strongly advise that students bring their own equipment to support their learning. The following items are recommended:

- Pencil case
- X2 Pens
- Pencil
- Coloured pencils
- Eraser
- Glue Stick
- Green pen
- Purple pen

- Highlighter
- Pair of Compasses
- Pencil Case
- Protractor
- Ruler
- Sharpener

We are selling equipment packs containing the items above for £5, if you would like your child to purchase one from school. These are available from Scopay www.scopay.com/hamble under 'Miscellaneous'. Once ordered the packs will be available on your child's first day in school.

In addition, students will need a calculator for Maths and their own personal hand sanitiser. Face coverings will be required if students are travelling to and from school using public transport, but should be disposed of in the bins provided at the entrance or packed away in a plastic bag at the start of the school day. ### THE FIRST DAY IN SCHOOL: YEAR 7

When Year 7 arrive on Monday 7th September they will guided to a line up area outside of the Main Hall to meet their tutors. At 08:30am there will be a year group assembly with Mr Govan and students will then spend the morning in their new tutor rooms getting to know their peers, key staff and routines at The Hamble School. Students will also be given their timetables and planners during the tutor sessions. In the afternoon they will attend their first lesson.

For the rest of the week students should arrive in school by 08:25am at the latest and go straight to their tutor bases (please see room details below). On Tuesday 8th September to Friday 11th September students will continue to spend periods 1 and 2 with their tutors but will go to their normal timetabled lessons for periods 3, 4 and 5.

## **ONLINE LESSONS** – YEARS 8-11

On Friday 4th September from 5pm students in Years 8 to 11 will be able to view their online lessons for next week on *Show My Homework*. On the days students are not in school they will have three Zoom lessons a day, plus additional support work to ensure that they are engaging in five hours of study (as they would in school).

The lessons will be with their new teachers and a register will be taken for attendance purposes. Work completed in these lessons must be brought into school. ## **ZOOM SAFETY FOR LIVE LESSONS**

A reminder of the Zoom safety guidance we sent out in the summer term – please go through this with your son/daughter.

- 1. Students will need to switch off their camera and microphone before joining. This protects their privacy and stops any background noise at your location from disturbing the lesson. These can be turned back on later, if they need to ask a question.
- 2. Please ensure that students are appropriately dressed in case they accidentally turn the camera on.
- 3. The lesson might be recorded this allows staff to play back the session e.g. for training purposes.
- 4. If students have a question, they can use the 'chat' feature and type their question.
- 5. Please ensure that students set their screen name to their first/surname as recorded on our school registered. For safeguarding reasons, they will not be allowed into the lesson under any other name.

Please follow the normal school rules of 'Ready, Respectful, Safe' for online lessons – the same as in a classroom.
