Intervention Tutor Groups - Year 11

As you are aware we are currently working with Year 10 students to ensure that they make the very best transition into Year 11. The GCSE year is focussed on academic success and we are committed to ensuring that all students secure excellent outcomes and achieve the qualifications needed to progress along their desired career path.

In September we will write to you outlining a comprehensive package of interventions, which include afterschool sessions, Masterclasses and tutor intervention. I want to inform you at this stage that your child will be allocated a new tutor in September. The tutor group will be allocated based on data from the Year 10 exams.
