We are delighted to inform you that students and staff at The Hamble School are celebrating after receiving a prestigious Artsmark Gold Award. This is a momentous year for the programme as it celebrates 20 years of arts, culture and creativity in schools.

The Artsmark Award is the only creative quality standard for schools, accredited by Arts Council England. It supports schools to develop and celebrate arts and cultural education, putting creativity and wellbeing at the heart of the curriculum. Artsmark ensures every young person can be creative and access a diverse, high-quality cultural education.

In order to achieve their Artsmark Award we had to develop our arts and culture provision to embed a broad and ambitious curriculum. This was achieved by creating an overall plan that was committed to and delivered across the whole school.

We were supported by Artswork in planning and developing our objectives. Artswork then worked alongside the school at various stages to support the Artsmark Award achievement The Artsmark assessor commended The Hamble School by saying 'Despite the challenges of Covid and some changes to senior staff, you have maintained your focus throughout Artsmark and have taken your prior dedication and strong offer to a new level by working with venues, partners, and in-school collaborations to bring both improvements to your own practice, and stronger outcomes to young people's learning
