Exam Warm up and Top up sessions

At The Hamble School we are committed to every student achieving their full potential in their examinations, to ensure they have every opportunity in further education and career pathways. With this in mind we have put together a thorough programme of structured revision lessons and warm up and top up sessions. The enclosed booklet provides a guide for you and your child for each of the sessions taking place between now and their final exam.

The Warm up sessions will run immediately before each exam and provide a last-minute revision booster session. Morning Warm up sessions will start at 8.20am and students are expected to attend the full session. May I ask you to support this initiative by making arrangements for your child to be in school and ready to start at 8.20am. Should you foresee any issues with this please contact me as soon as possible – nemmett-callaghan@thehambleschool.co.uk. Afternoon Warm up sessions will start at 12.20 until 12.50pm.

Top up sessions will normally take place the day before each exam. Your child's teacher will provide support in covering topics that students feel they need to strengthen before the final exam. These sessions will usually last an hour and will take place either within the school day or, where necessary, during intervention time at the end of the day immediately prior to the exam.

There will also be revision sessions running during the May half term and at weekends, these sessions were extremely well received by previous Year 11 students.

- Thursday 25th August – Results day 10-11.30pm
