### **Year 11 Science Timetable Changes**

As part of our continued commitment to improving outcomes for all students in Science I am writing to inform you that after half term we will be restructuring how the Science curriculum is delivered.

Students will remain in the same Science class for the moment, however, most will now have two Science teachers who will share the lessons between them. This will allow our staff to teach in their Biology, Chemistry or Physics specialism and provide students with deeper contextual understanding of the content being taught.

We will also be providing students with one extra science lesson over the fortnight to focus on deeper learning, Science skills and revision. This change has already been introduced in Year 10 to great success, and is further supported by current pedagogical thinking both in Hampshire and nationally.
