Year 7 Formal Examinations

As you are aware from the Weekly Message, Year 7 formal examinations will take place during the week commencing **Monday 15 April 2024**. This is a very good opportunity for the students to familiarise themselves with the examination process in readiness for their examinations in forthcoming years. The examinations are also very useful tools for teachers to ensure that they close any knowledge/ skills gaps before children start Year 8.

Please find enclosed with this letter and a copy of the Year 7 examination timetable. English, Maths and Science examinations will take place in the Sports Hall in GCSE examination conditions. All other examinations will take place during normal lesson times, in GCSE exam conditions. Teachers will add the date for the examination to Class Charts.
