## Year 8 Formal Examinations

As per the Weekly Message, I am writing to inform you that the Year 8 formal examinations will be taking place during the week commencing **Monday 22 April 2024**. This is a very good opportunity for the students to familiarise themselves with the examination process in readiness for their examinations in forthcoming years.

Please find enclosed with this letter, a copy of the Year 8 examination timetable. English, Maths and Science examinations will take place in the Sports Hall in GCSE examination conditions. All other examinations will take place during normal lesson times and in GCSE exam conditions and teachers will put the dates on Class Charts.

Students will receive guidance during an assembly on our expectations towards examinations and their conduct during examinations. Students who qualify for access arrangements will have their needs met by the Learning Support team and will take their examinations in an alternative venue to accommodate their needs.

Please discuss your child's examinations with them and encourage them to revise in readiness for each examination.
