Red Nose Day – Friday 18th March

As a school we aim to teach the importance of thinking of others less fortunate than ourselves. This term the School Council voted to raise funds for Red Nose Day.

On the day we will be hosting a Cake Bake event where students can bring in cakes to sell to raise money for the cause. The Cake Bake will be run as a house competition with every student who bakes cakes earning house points and prizes for:
