Once loaded, scroll down and click on the Parents' Evening Booking link - "click here". Please be aware that you must complete all login fields and select "**Year 9 Parents'/Carers' Evening**". The appointments are five-minute slots and you may see as many of your child's teachers as you wish. In special circumstances, teachers or Year Leaders may contact you directly to arrange a meeting to ensure your child is making the expected progress in their learning.

We would encourage you to make appointments with as many of your child's subject teachers as possible so that you can discuss your child's progress and understand how your child can improve in each of their subjects. Should you be unable to book an appointment with a teacher of your choosing, please leave a request for contact in our parents' evening contact book which will be available on the evening at the back of the Hall.

Staff will be located in the Main Hall, Drama Studio and adjoining classrooms, which will be signposted for your convenience.

Please note that all students attending must be in full School uniform.
