Year 9 Preference Process

We are now making plans for the curriculum your son/ daughter will follow starting September 2023. The time has come to consider which Key Stage 4 courses are most appropriate for your child as they move into Year 10. This is an important decision, and we want to ensure that you and your child are as informed as possible.

At The Hamble School, we are determined to offer each and every student a curriculum that suits their individual needs, while complying with national recommendations and guidelines. In summary, your child will continue with their studies in English, Maths, Science, Core PE and PSHCRE. This time last year, your child also chose 6 subjects to study in Year 9. Moving into Year 10, your child will carry 4 of these on to GCSE/BTEC level.

We will be launching a preference webpage on 22 February to ensure that you and your son/ daughter receive all the information required to make informed decisions The webpage will include all the details of the curriculum model, preference process and information from each subject about the courses on offer.

We have outlined the Preference Process below:

Date	Activity	Aim
W/b 20th February	Year 9 Preferences session in tutor and Taster session selection	To inform students about the Preferences Process and about making choices.
22 nd February	Launch of the Preference webpage	To provide students and parents/ carers with detailed information about different subject courses.
23 rd February	Parents evening	To enable students and parents/carers to ask questions about the Year 10 curriculum and the preference process and current progress.
W/b 27 th February	Taster sessions to be held	To ensure students are fully aware of what each subject will entail at GCSE/BTEC level
6 th March	Preference form to be emailed out	To complete detailing subject ranking.
17 th March	Preference Form Deadline	Forms must be completed by this date.
June/July	Confirmation of student subject choices	A letter will be sent home to confirm allocation of subject choices.
