
Welcome to DofE 2026!





Expectations

The DofE bronze award is your responsibility. You will be in charge of the following:

- Attending your training sessions or discussing your absence with your leader
- Managing your 3 sections including evidence and assessors reports
- 3) Communicating updates with home
- 4) Behaving in a suitable manner both in school and when out on training walks and expedition



Your award

You will need to manage your progress to completing your rewards and checking your EDofE account regularly.

We will provide guidelines for your 3 sections but you will need to upload evidence and ensure completion of a

minimum of 1 hour a week.
