### **Year 11 Rivers Geography Fieldtrip – March 2026**

As part of the GCSE Geography course, it is a requirement for all students to complete geography fieldwork. Their fieldwork skills and knowledge are then assessed in an exam paper at the end of Year 11, which is worth 30% of the final grade.

#### **Aim:**

To conduct a Geography enquiry by collecting primary data for the rivers fieldwork component of the GCSE Geography examination. We have arranged a trip to the New Forest to investigate the river processes of Highland Water.

#### **Date: Tuesday 10 March**

**Times:** Students must arrive promptly and register at 8:25am in D4. The trip will begin at 8:30am, within the school day, and will return in time for lunch at 1:20pm.

**Transport:** Coach travel to the New Forest

**Contribution:** £12.50

#### **Important Information**

Students need to wear suitable outdoor clothing and must be prepared to wade in a shallow stream. High-sided wellies to change into are recommended, or wet-shoes are also acceptable.

As the weather may be unpredictable, students should check the forecast the day before and ensure they bring appropriate items such as a coat, sunscreen, and a change of clothing if not wearing waterproofs.

Due to the nature of the trip and the risks associated with entering shallow water, excellent behaviour is essential. Students will be representing The Hamble School and must follow the school rules: Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Safe.
