

Kid Normal




Batman: Nightwalker

Returning home from his lavish eighteenth birthday party, Bruce Wayne stops a criminal's getaway - disobeying the police and crashing his car during the chase.


Sentenced to community service in Gotham City's Arkham Asylum, he encounters some of the city's most dangerous and mentally disturbed criminals.
