






## **Life on the Refrigerator Door** **Alice Kuipers**


## **A Thousand Boy Kisses** **Tillie Cole**


## **13 Reasons Why** **Jay Asher**


**Before I Die**


**The Memory Book**


**Maybe One Day**

## **One** **Sarah Crossan**



## **All the Bright Places** **Jennifer Niven**



When Finch and Violet meet on the ledge of the bell tower at school, it's unclear who saves whom.




## **I'll Give You the Sun** **Jandy Nelson**


## **The Honest Truth** **Dan Gemeinhart**


## **And the Stars were Burning Brightly** **Danielle Jawando**


## **I Was Here** **Gayle Forman**


## **Five Feet Apart** **Rachel Lippincott**


## **A Monster Calls** **Patrick Ness**


## **Sorry for Your Loss** **Jessie Ann Foley**


## **They Both Die at the End** **Adam Silvera**








## **How to Make Friends with the Dark**

It's the brightest day of summer and it's dark outside. It's dark in your house, dark in your room, and dark in your heart. You feel like the darkness is going to split you apart.





## **The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas**




## **My Sister Lives on the Mantelpiece** **Annabel Pitcher**


## **The Last Time We Say Goodbye** **Cynthia Hand**




### **Broken Hearts and Zombie Parts** **William Hussey**

Jesse Spark has a broken heart and in a few short weeks he'll require major surgery to repair it - which means he only has a month to accomplish two almost-impossible tasks.


- 1) Shoot his epic zombie movie on a shoestring budget if he has any hope of getting into film school.

with a huge scar - because how will anyone ever fancy him after that?




### **This Book Will Make You Cry** **Daniel Tawse**


## **Ghosted** **Emily Barr**
