### **Southampton School Dance Festival Performance – Year 9**

I am pleased to inform you that our Dance Department has been offered the exciting opportunity to participate in the Southampton Schools Dance Festival at Bitterne Park School on Thursday 2 July. Our students will have the chance to perform a dance piece they have been studying and working towards throughout this term. This festival represents a fantastic platform for our dancers to showcase their hard work and talent to a wider audience.

Please note that attendance is not compulsory; however, participating in this event will be a valuable experience and an excellent performance opportunity for your child.

Students will need to report to the exam line-up area at 2:00pm to register for the visit, ensuring a prompt departure from The Hamble School at 2:35pm. Students will travel by minibus to Bitterne Park School, Southampton, arriving in time for the 3:30pm technical run prior to the performance. The event is expected to finish at approximately 7:30pm.

If you would prefer to collect your child directly from the venue or make alternative travel arrangements, please contact me in advance via email to confirm the details. Otherwise, the minibus is expected to return to school at approximately 8:00pm. We kindly ask parents and carers to remain flexible with this return time, as it may be subject to change due to unforeseen traffic delays.

Students are expected to wear full school PE uniform and bring black leggings and a plain black top to perform in as part of their costume. As they will be representing The Hamble School in the wider community, normal school rules apply for this visit. As the visit departs at the end of Period 5 during the school day, students must bring a packed meal to eat in the evening.


