

TAILORED SHORTS GUIDANCE

At The Hamble School, students may wear plain navy tailored shorts all year round as part of our Uniform Policy.

Shorts must be smart, tailored, knee length and suitable for a school environment. They should be made from woven school trouser fabric, be plain navy in colour and have a formal appearance. Shorts may be plain or school branded and may have a flat front or an elasticated back.

Shorts must not be sportswear, casual wear or fashion shorts. They must not have logos (except Hamble branded from Skoolkit), cargo pockets or be made from jersey, denim or athletic materials.
